插图：For the Industrial plants , however , the Government took little action until almost a year ago when it fostered the Industrial Cooperatives. It immediately solved four outstanding problems precipitated by Japan's wanton destruction of China's industrial centers. First. it provided a way for China to mobilize its economic and industrial resources so as to increase her power of resistance. Secondly , it created a new basis for China's economic structure by giving rise to domestic industries. Thirdly , it provided work for the refugees who had been thrown out of employment in consequence of the industrial plants having fallen into the hands of the enemy. Fourthly , it helped to salvage and rescue from the threatened areas the machinery and transplant them to the interior where the Work could be revived.
