Passage B Hotels When you are traveling, whether on business or for pleasure, you often need to stay in a hotel. The kind of hotel you choose is probably decided above all according to how much money you want to spend. There are small hotels with very few services, where the prices are low; or there are large hotels with all the very latest comforts, where you could spend all the money you have in the bank for one very comfortable night. There are several different kinds of people who go to hotels. Some want to live, rather than just stay, in a hotel, the hotels which are designed to meet their needs are called residential hotels. However, most people who stay in hotels are either business people or tourists on vacation. Some hotels are designed particularly for one of these two groups: commercial hotels are usually located in the business section of a town, while vacation hotels (which are also called tourist hotels) may be by the sea, in the mountains, or near other beauty spots. In large cities, many of the hotels are redesigned for both kinds of guests.

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
