Tracing the rootsof the word further back into linguistic history, it seemsto have been a combination of the Indo-European stem'guit-', meaning music, and the root '-tar', meaning chordor string. The root '-tar' is actually common to a number of languages, and can also be found in the word 'sitar', also a stringed musical instrument. While the guitar may have gained most of its popularityas a musical instrument during the modern era, guitar-likeinstruments have been in existence in numerous culturesthroughout the world for more than 5,000 years. Theearliest instruments that the modern eye and ear wouldrecognise as a'normal'acoustic guitar date from about 500years ago. Prior to this time, stringed instruments were inuse throughout the world, but these early instrumentsare known primarily from visual depictions, not from the continued existence of music written for them. The majority of these depictions show simple stringedinstruments, often lacking some of the parts that define amodern guitar. A number of these instruments have morein common with the lute than the guitar.
