### 内容概要

《外研社·英语同义词辨析词典》共选编了1000多组英语同义词和近义词，涉及词汇5700余个。所选词汇主要以教育部对高等学校非英语专业本科生的推荐词汇量为基准，即4795个单词和700个词组（含中学应掌握的词汇），同时参照《大学英语课程教学要求》中所附的《大学英语参考词汇表》，对其中所列的单词尽量予以吸收，基本涵盖了英语学习中经常遇到的同义词和近义词问题。

## 章节摘录

版权页： assert, contend, maintain  
assert v. 坚决主张；断言。

【辨析】含较强的主观意味，指坚决而明确地表示某事真实无误。

【例证】She asserted that French cooking is the best in the world. 她坚称法国菜是世界上最好的。

The scientist asserted that there is no water on the moon 那位科学家断言月球上没有水。

contend v. 主张，声称。

(辨析)指声称某事属实，含有与他人进行争辩的意思。

【例证】He contended that it was true. 他声称那是真的。

I would contend that unemployment is the most serious social problem today. 我认为失业是当今最为严重的社会弊病。

maintain v. 坚持说，坚持认为。

(辨析)指坚决维护某种主张或观点等。

【例证】She maintained her innocence. 她坚持自己是无辜的。

He maintains that he once saw a UFO. 他坚称自己曾看见过飞碟。

assume, presume, suppose (导航词义：推测，假定) assume v. 设想，假定。

【辨析】指想当然地将未经证实的事当真，比较武断。

【例证】I didn't see your cell phone, so I assumed you'd left. 我没看见你的手机，所以我以为你离开了。

Assuming that Dad agrees, when do you want to shop for a Dew car? 假设爸爸同意，你打算什么时候买新汽车？  
presume v. (正式)假设，假定。

(辨析)常指以已有的经验、信息等为依据进行合乎逻辑的推测、推断，但结论可能有误。

(例证) This logical analysis presumes the separation of subject from object. 该逻辑分析假定主体与客体是分开的。

I presume that this price includes all transportation and accommodation fees. 我猜测，这个价钱包括一切交通费用和住宿费。

suppose v. (正式)假定；猜想。

(辨析)指在某一前提下或根据已有知识、信息等进行推测，有时用于表达意见。

【例证】The company's plan supposes a steady increase in wheat yield. 公司的这个计划假定小麦产量会稳定增加。

What makes him suppose they're going to quit? 他凭什么认为他们要离职？  
assurance, insurance (导航词义：保险) assurance n. (英) 保险。

【辨析】行业术语，只用于人寿保险。

(例证) a life assurance company 人寿保险公司 insurance n. 保险。

【辨析】普通用词，可用于一切保险。

(例证) fire / health / travel insurance 火险 / 健康险 / 旅游险 He is an insurance broker. 他是一名保险经纪人。

Does she have insurance on her house? 她买住房保险了吗？  
athlete, sportsman, sportsperson (导航词义：运动员) athlete n. 运动员。

【辨析】指参加体育比赛的人，尤指田径运动员。

【例证】These professional athletes are well-trained 这些专业运动员训练有素。

A good athlete should have skill, strength and speed. 一个好的运动员应该具备技能、体力和速度。

sportsman n. (尤英) 运动员；参加体育运动者。

【辨析】指参加体育运动者，尤指擅长体育运动的人，现常表示“男运动员”，与 sportswoman (女运动员) 相对应。



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
